This report aims to provide a comprehensive understanding of the patent filing process, covering the necessary steps and considerations for individuals or organizations seeking patent protection for their inventions.

Dr Tiwari said that Patents serve as legal instruments that grant inventors exclusive rights to their inventions, preventing others from making, using, or selling the patented invention without permission. This exclusivity provides a competitive advantage and encourages innovation by ensuring inventors can benefit from their creations.

He added Understanding what can be patented is fundamental. Not all inventions are eligible for patent protection. Patentable subject matter typically includes processes, machines, manufactures, compositions of matter, and improvements thereof. However, abstract ideas, laws of nature, and naturally occurring phenomena are

Generally, not patentable.

He suggested to follow the steps:

7. File with Patent Office: Submit the application to the



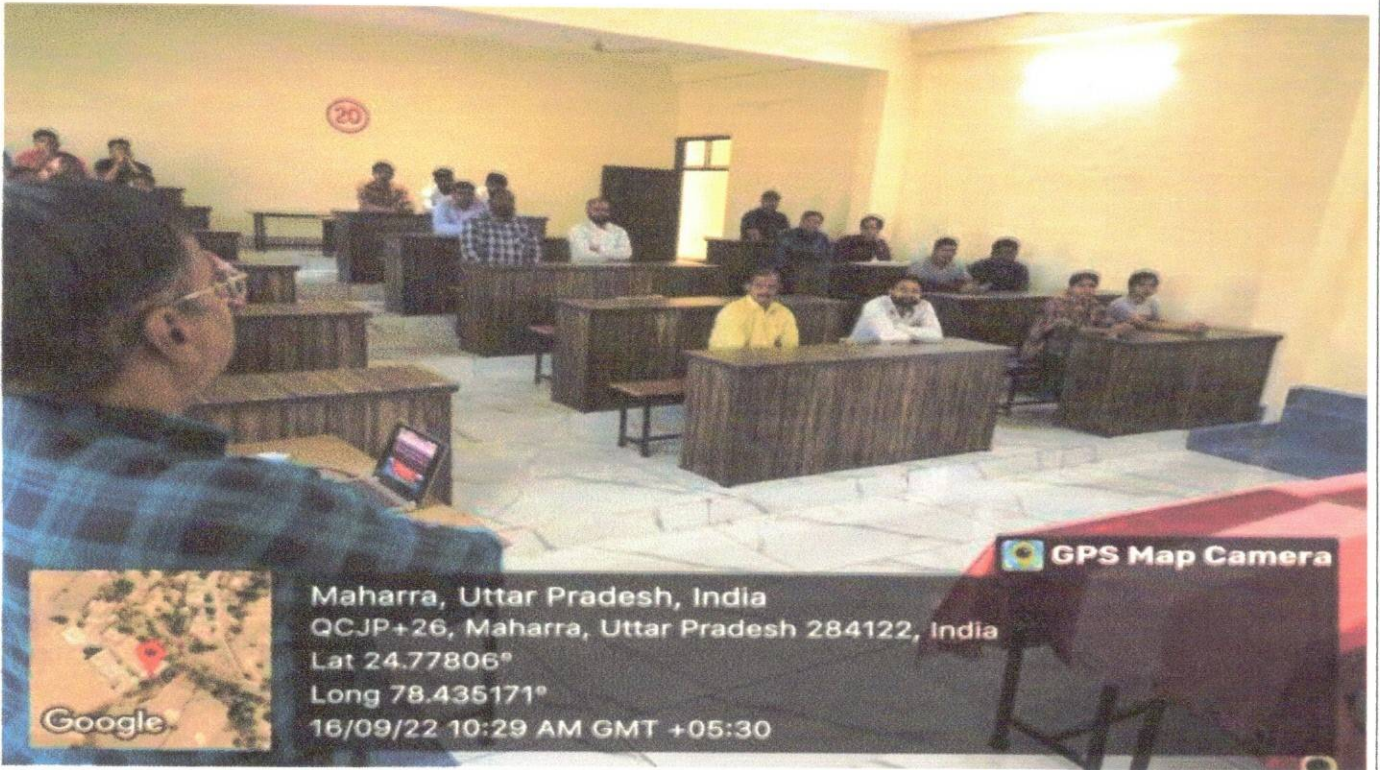
